Using the Cost Sharing program allows you to devote your attention to a successful cycle without worrying about your finances.

It helped reduce the stress in an already **very** stressful situation which helps the whole reproductive process.

Took the stress off of the financial burden once the money was paid up front.

It provided peace of mind and allowed us to focus on the procedure and not the finances.

When our first trial didn't work, it was extremely difficult, and I can't imagine how much more difficult it would have been to know if we wanted to try again, we'd have to get into the whole financial side of this already stressful situation again.

Cost sharing allowed us to be able to afford to try to conceive, but with incentive of getting dollars back if unsuccessful! Luck would have it; we didn't have to worry though. It worked!

All over again - Yes ... Even though we were ultimately unsuccessful after our three attempts, I am glad that we gave it a shot.

It provided peace of mind.

We were successful on our 2nd IVF and the cost sharing program greatly reduced the stress while cycling.

Knowing we had multiple cycles made the process less stressful. It was no longer all or nothing. IVF worked on first try.

There are no guarantees when you are dealing with infertility and the emotional and financial struggles are very stressful. Knowing you have three attempts and frozen attempts relieves stress. And knowing if none of it works, you can get some money back was very important. Of course, if you get pregnant on the first attempt like we did, you paid double, but we got twins so we like to think that we got our money's worth. Truthfully, we were happy to pay any amount for a baby, three reason cost sharing was appealing is because there are no guarantees. We didn't know if it would take one attempt or three.

Even though we didn't need to do IVF multiple times (we were successful the first time); the stress was not there as much.

...less stress, similar to an insurance policy

We were unsuccessful with IVF three times and the refund helped us with adoption expenses.

Cost sharing was less stressful while going through the procedure and you get more cycles for your dollar than other centers I looked into.

Cost sharing really took the stress and pressure out of the IVF experience. It is an expensive procedure and the last thing you need to worry about is how you are going to pay for the next attempt if it fails.

Makes IVF affordable. We could never have afforded as many cycles if we were paying per treatment.
